CONNECTING THE CAMERA TO YOUR WIRELESS NETWORK (Recommended Ethernet method)

Please note the camera can only be connected to a 2.4ghz network. If your router is also able to operate at 5ghz (Dualband), the 2.4ghz MUST be given a different name (SSID) to the 5ghz network and the connection made to the 2.4ghz network only. Further details on changing the SSID of your router are available from your ISP / Router manufacturer.

Situate your camera next to the router and connect it to the router using the supplied ethernet cable.

Plug the camera into the mains, and leave around 30 seconds for it to connect to your network.

1. Open the App on your phone, and select the option to add a camera.

 Use the scan button to scan the QR code on the under side of the camera, or alternatively the code from the bottom of the QR code label can be typed into the UID Box. The default password of 'admin' should also be entered in the Security Code box. Press the OK button in the bottom right.



4. Press the camera to access the live feed



 It will then ask you to create a new password for the unit, please enter the old password as admin, and type a new password twice before clicking next.

If you do not require the camera to communicate with your router wirelessly installation is now complete.

11. The Wifi connection status will be displayed in the Wi-Fi Setting section of the Advanced Settings screen. Once this shows as connected, Press OK to exit the screen, disconnect the Ethernet cable, and the camera can now be viewed wirelessly.
