

It's easy to move files like documents, email, photos, music, and movies When you start your MacBook Pro for the first time, Setup Assistant launches to get you going. Follow a few simple steps to connect to your Wi-Fi network to your new Mac from another Mac or a PC. The first time you start your transfer your stuff from another Mac or a PC, create a user account for your new Mac, it will walk you through the transfer process. All you have to do is follow the onscreen instructions

Your Apple ID lets you download apps from the App Store, shop the iTunes Store and the Apple Online Store, access iCloud, and communicate using FaceTime. If you don't have an Apple ID, creating one is easy and free.






