



GETTING STARTED


Connection tests are recommended before fitting the camera in its final location.

Optional support




Secure the multi-position Camera Bracket using the two screws. If needed, two anchors are also included.


Optional support



Hang the camera and plate onto the hanger screws. Arrange cable properly so that it will not block pan/tilt operation.



Connect the small end of the AC 3 adapter to the camera's DC in Jack.



Plug it into the outlet you want to use.



- 1 From your smart device, **download** and **install** the free **KODAK Security Application**.
- 2 **Plug the camera** into an electrical outlet (allow the camera up to **60 seconds** to boot up).
- 3 On your Apple device, **open the Settings App**. Tap **Wi-Fi** and under **Choose A Network**, select the **HD-XXXXXX Network**.
- 4 When asked for a password, **enter « 12345678 »**. Tap **Join** to connect.
- 5 Now Launch the **KODAK Security Application**.
- 6 Tap « + » to start the installation and select « **Wifi cameras** ».
- 7 Once connected, the screen will indicate that the camera has been successfully configured.
- 8 You will be prompted for a password change. **Enter a password, remember it** or write it.
- 9 Tap « **Wifi Settings** », select your **Wifi network**, and **enter the corresponding password**.
- 10 **Wait 90 seconds** for the camera to appear connected. You will find your camera in the list of cameras of your application.
- 11 Tap « **Live View** » for live video





1 From your smart device, **download** and **install** the free **KODAK Security Application**

2 Tape « + » on screen for direct wireless connection of the camera to the application.

3 **Plug the camera** into an electrical outlet (allow the camera up to **90 seconds** to boot up).

4 The App will start the connection process.

5 Once found, the Change Password screen will appear **Enter a password** and **remember it** or write it down for future use.

Tape « OK ».

6 The Setup Wi-Fi Network **pop-up box will appear**. **Select your home network** from the menu, and then **enter your home network's Wireless Password**.
Tape « OK ».

7 The screen shows that the camera has been set up successfully.

Tape « OK ».

8 You will find your camera in the list of cameras of your application. Wait **90 seconds** for the camera to appear connected.

9 Tap **image** for live video.



Live Viewing

1 Tap **preview Picture**.

Pinch and Zoom:

To zoom in or out, use the simple **pinch** and **zoom gesture** with this app.



Features

1 Tap to **CAPTURE**

Screen images in **Live View**.

Images automatically save to smartphone's camera roll or gallery.

2 Tap to **RECORD**.

One-minute (approx.)

Recordings save to microSD card on the side of camera; see **diagram page** for location (**microSD card not included**).


3 Tap to **turn volume ON/OFF** in the Live View mode.

4 Tap to **access** the preset menu.

5 To **speak** into your Android or Apple device to the camera's speaker, tap **and hold** this icon and **speak**; the voice will be heard through the camera's speaker.

Live View Recording on microSD Card

1 Insert a microSD as shown.



*microSD card (not included) is required to record video to camera.

2 Manually Record video from Live View by tapping **Record icon**.

Recording will **stop after** approximately **one minute**.

Motion Recording

3 To set Motion Activated Recording, Go to **Advanced Setting** in App > **Sensitivity Settings** to selected options. The Advanced Settings will ask for the **admin password**; default password is **123456**.

You can **change** the default password within the **Advanced Settings**.

Add Sensors

Your camera can work with up to 6 KODAK Security Accessories : Door Sensor, Motion sensor or remote control. Please follow the installation process as below :

1 Tap  in camera Panel

2 In the advanced section, enter **admin password** default **123456**.

3 Select **sensor setup**.

Tap «+» to add **sensor device**.

If you already remove the batteries protection plastic, please **open the cover, remove** and **reinstall** the battery

4 Name your device and tap «**save**».

5 Tap «**Camera Pan control**» to calibrate the camera position, and **save** the settings.
